Enhanced Skin Rejuvenation: The Treatment for Sun Damaged Skin, Red and Brown Pigment Irregularities and Fine Wrinkles

What are the benefits? Enhanced Skin Rejuvenation is ideal for eliminating a variety of problems including:

- broken capillaries
- wrinkles
- rosacea
- spider veins
- age spots/sun spots
- large pores
- freckles
- flushing
- pigmentation variances

How does it work?

Laser light is absorbed by pigmented areas where it is converted to heat, causing a breakup in the pigment. In broken capillaries and spider veins, the laser energy is absorbed by the pigment in the blood and collapses the unwanted vein. For wrinkles and skin toning, the laser stimulates collagen production to fight back Father Time and show more of what Mother Nature originally gave you. Some clients require more emphasis on one type of blemish than another to achieve the desired results. Dr. O'Brien will analyze your skin condition and help you select the most effective treatment or treatment series for you.

When will you see results?

Effects are cumulative. After the first treatment you will see improvements in fine capillaries, small facial veins and pigmented areas within a few days. Other improvements such as wrinkle reduction and toning will be more subtle and may take 1-3 months (usually evident after three treatments.) With each subsequent treatment, subtle changes will accumulate until you have achieved the improvement you desire.

How often can you have it done?

A series of one to six treatments, spaced 2 to 4 weeks apart, is commonly recommended. Fewer treatments are typically required if pigment irregularities are the primary concern. Occasionally, more treatments may be needed for certain individuals or conditions. Periodic occasional maintenance treatments may be prescribed for optimal, lasting results.

What can you expect immediately after treatment?

Immediately following the procedure you may experience some mild redness, swelling and/or a darkening of pigmented areas. The redness and swelling usually dissipate within one to three days however, darkened pigmentation may persist for one week. Makeup can be applied to the treated area immediately, if desired. Additionally, hair growth may be impaired in the treated area, although it is not the intended purpose of this particular treatment. It is extremely important to apply a moisturizer with SPF30 or higher sunblock, and avoid sun exposure on a daily basis to prevent new sun damage.

How long does it take and how much does it cost?

This treatment takes between 10 and 60 minutes, depending on the size of the treated area. Treatment of brown and red pigment irregularities only may require less time and the cost would therefore be less. Typically, topical anesthetics are not necessary for this treatment but can be prescribed if needed. Dr. O'Brien will discuss what to expect and answer additional questions at your consultation. The following times are typical estimates, and prices are based on laser & prep time required. Prices are subject to change without notice.
