What are the benefits?

Laser acne treatments offer a no-downtime approach to help clear acne lesions and help reduce the severity of future breakouts. You can return to work or school immediately after treatment – the only side effect will be facial redness for a few hours similar to “wind burn.” Laser treatments do not have the side effects seen with oral and topical treatments. Laser treatments do not induce prolonged dryness, severe redness or depression like Accutane can.

How does it work?

The laser light is absorbed in the skin which helps mobilize the body's own defenses and reduce bacteria counts. Our standard recommendation is one treatment twice weekly for 2 weeks. Dr. O'Brien will analyze your skin condition and help you select the most effective treatment for you.

When will you see results?

Effects are cumulative. After the first treatment, you might see improvements. The number of acne lesions and severity of breakouts should reduce over the course of treatment and beyond. Most patients continue to improve 3 months after their last treatment. Red and brown pigment irregularities, which often add to complexion problems in acne, respond very well to this treatment.

How often can you have it done?

The typical course of treatments is 2 weeks, two treatments per week. However, Dr. O'Brien might recommend a different treatment schedule.

What can you expect immediately after treatment?

Immediately following the procedure you may experience some redness and slight swelling. The redness and swelling usually dissipate within 1 to 3 days. If necessary, makeup can be applied to the treated area immediately. It is extremely important to apply a moisturizer with SPF 30 sun-block and avoid sun exposure on a daily basis to prevent routine sun damage. Our estheticians can assist you in your general skin care program.

How long does it take and how much does it cost?

Each treatment takes approximately 20-30 minutes, depending on the area to be treated. The individual treatment charge is based on the time required to effectively treat the desired area. The total cost will typically be the per-treatment charge multiplied by 4 since four treatments are most commonly prescribed. Prices are subject to change without notice.
