LYNN COOK HARTWIG SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



In 1996 Hattiesburg Clinic organized a golf tournament in honor of Lynn Cook Hartwig, Ph.D. for her commendable contributions to the field of health policy education in South Mississippi. The funds raised allowed Hattiesburg Clinic to endow annual scholarships in the College of Health at The University of Southern Mississippi (USM).

The success of the golf tournament has made it possible for Hattiesburg Clinic to enhance the scholarship program. In addition to the endowed scholarships at USM, as funds allow, the Clinic will also provide scholarships to Jones County Jr. College and Pearl River Community College. Students must meet eligibility requirements.

Selection Criteria

- Applicants must be citizens of the United States of America.
- Applicants must be accepted or enrolled as full-time students at USM, Jones County Junior College or *Pearl River Community College.
*PRCC students need only to fill out the PRCC scholarship application form located at the Financial Aid Office to be considered for this scholarship.
- Community college students must be pursuing a degree in a health-related field.
- Applicants must have a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale and a minimum ACT score of 16.
- Leadership qualities, demonstrated by participation in school, church and other community service activities, may be taken into consideration during the selection process after all other requirements are met.
- Applicants may be selected based on financial need.

Selection Process

Applications for the Lynn Cook Hartwig Scholarship must be made at the beginning of each academic year. Application forms can be picked up at the individual school where the appli-

cant is applying, Hattiesburg Clinic Human Resources or *hattiesburgclinic.com*. After completion, applications should be turned in to either the USM office of Financial Aid or the JCJC Foundation Office. Application deadlines are determined by each school.

The scholarship amount will be determined by November 30th of each academic year; the scholarship will be awarded in the spring semester of the upcoming school year.

Consideration will be given to applicants who are employees or children of employees at Hattiesburg Clinic.

Each school will select the scholarship winners based on the aforementioned criteria.

Retention of Scholarship

- Each recipient must maintain a 2.5 grade point average during the award year to retain a Lynn Cook Hartwig Scholarship.
- Character, citizenship and the applicant's potential for making positive contributions to their community and society shall be considered in awarding the "Lynn Cook Hartwig Scholarship".
- Standard financial aid retention policies prearranged by each school must be followed.
