Exploring 'MEGA Heart'

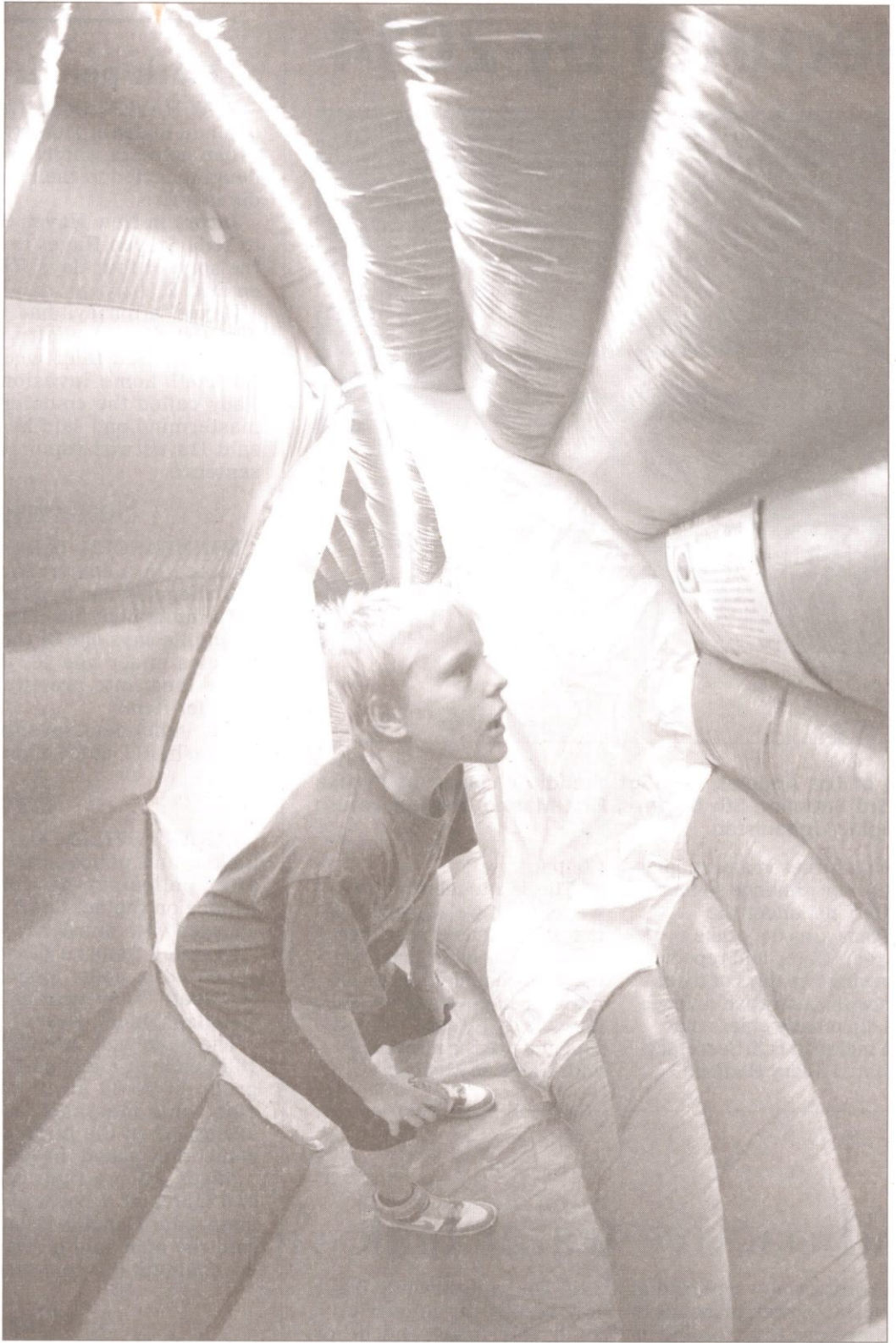
