Pediatric Therapy Services

■ **Speech Therapy:**

- Auditory processing and memory activities
- Augmentative communication training
- Language intervention activities
- Oral-sensory / feeding activities
- Social skills activities

■ **Occupational Therapy:**

- Assessment for adaptive equipment
- Cognitive / perceptual therapy
- Self-care skills
- Sensory motor activities
- Social skills activities

■ **Physical Therapy:**

- Assessment for adaptive equipment
- Functional mobility
- Neuromuscular re-education
- Positioning to normalize tone
- Therapeutic exercises and activities

Duration of Treatment

The frequency and duration of treatment is based on goals that are established by the therapist, patient and patient's family.

Frequency, duration and overall treatment plan may need to be adjusted based on the patient's response to therapeutic interventions provided by the patient's caregivers.



Patient Criteria

A physician referral is not required for pediatric therapy services, but it may be required by the patient's health insurance company.

Patient Billing
