

Rangerettes donate to LHC for mammograms

The Rangerette Reunion recently donated \$6,149 to the Livingston HealthCare Foundation.

The funds are earmarked specifically for mammograms for people without health insurance and who cannot otherwise afford to pay for the cost of the screening, said Debbie Nelson, a leader of the Rangerettes.

"We're both thrilled and honored to receive this generous donation from the Rangerettes," LHC spokeswoman Sandi Marlowe said.

The funds were raised through a series of events that included selling homemade crafts and goodies at the Livingston Farmers Market; a raffle for a Kin-

dle e-reader; a large garage sale at the Livingston Civic Center; a silent auction; and a 50/50 promotion at Summerfest.

The main event was the Rangerette's performance in the Livingston Roundup Parade on July 2, which included a float and the top prize of Best Of Parade by the parade judges.

The Rangerettes plan to continue raising funds for mammograms and support of breast cancer patients, Nelson said.

The nonprofit organization is accepting donations, which are tax-deductible, Nelson said.
