# \$20,000 for breast cancer prevention

Livingston HealthCare now has \$20,000 to put toward breast cancer prevention, courtesy of the of the Susan G. Komen for the Cure organization.

The Montana affiliate of the nonprofit group that raises funds for breast cancer research, awareness and other efforts has awarded LHC a grant to help Park County and surrounding

areas, LHC announced this week.

The grant will establish a "fund to pay for mammograms for women who are uninsured or underinsured," according to an LHC press release. LHC estimates that only 53 percent of Park County women who should be getting annual mammograms to aid in breast cancer detection actually use the screening tool.

Komen's gift also will support breast

cancer prevention and general breast health education programs, such as the Paint Park County Pink campaign that LHC will launch in July. The program will include direct mailings, advertisements and events.
