• **DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONES: 3 - 4 Years.**

Gross motor:

- Hops and stands on one foot for 5 seconds
- Able to walk upstairs and downstairs without support
- Throws ball overhand
- Moves forward and backward with agility

Fine motor:

- Draws circles and squares
- Draws a person with 2 to 4 body parts
- Begins to copy some capital letters

Social:

- Cooperates with other children and likes to play "mom" and "dad".
- Dresses and undresses
- Negotiates solutions to conflicts
- Cannot distinguish between fantasy and reality, many unfamiliar images seen as "monsters".

Cognitive:

- Correctly names some colors
- Understands concept of counting and knows a few numbers
- Recalls parts of a story
- Understands a clearer sense of time
- Understands the concept of same/different

Language:

- Uses sentences of 5 to 6 words and masters a few basic rules of grammar
- Speaks clearly enough for strangers to understand
- Has mastered some basic rules of grammar
